Prague 'A' Grade Womens Epee 28/29th Jan 2006

Jo Maynard competed in the Prague 'A' Grade this weekend, fighting amongst the world's elite. She fenced extremely well and won 4/6 fights in the 1st round (losing one 4-5). This gave her a bye to the Last 96 which she won to get through to the Last 64. The following day the competition resumed and Jo was joined by two other Brits who also made the cut - Jo Beadsworth and Mary Cohen. Unfortunately they lost their next fight, but a good result for Mary - well done!

Jo faced a tough opponent in the L64, number 17th seed Sancho from Spain. A bad start saw her trail 6-1, but she fought hard and never gave up, winning 12-11 in the final minute! Into the Last 32 she faced a strong Pole and unfortunately lost 15-9. The Polish girl beat Sonja Tol of Holland (top ten in the world) to reach the next round, and then won another fight to finish in third place, losing only to the eventual winner and World No.1 Sherraine MacKay from Canada. Well done to Jo for a well earned 4 World Cup points!!

One Two Six Beginner Wins Gold!!*

One Two Six Fencers excelled themselves this weekend winning no less than 6 medals - 2 Gold, 2 Silver and 2 Bronze.

Ken Hanstock fenced brilliantly in the Intermediate epee winning the silver medal. In the semi-final Ken fought back from two hits down with only seconds to go to equal the score 8 - 8 against Ian Rugheimer (LTFC), and then went on to take the final hit to win 9-8. Although he lost the final bout, his second place is a marvellous achievement - well done!

Our women epeeists dominated the Novice Epee competition, claiming the top 4 seed places after the poule round. Fighting between themselves for the medal places, the final positions were: 1st Kate Warburton, 2nd Barbara Wanzenried, 3rd= Tarina Starkey and Margaret Ryan. Fantastic results all round and congratulations to Tarina on gaining a bronze in her first competition!

In the Men's Novice Epee Competition, we had Ali, Parv and Giles competing. For Giles this was his second competition of the day after having fenced in the Intermediate Foil earlier (a very credible L16 place). Giles last fenced in a competition in 1988 and coped very well after such a long absence. Although tiring towards the end of the day after so many fights, he still put in a great performance and gained a L8 in the epee.

For Ali and Parv this was their first competition, having only two months' fencing experience. Although they felt a little out of their depth at the start they soon found their feet and fenced intelligently and relaxed as the competition progressed. Ali finished a very credible L8 and Parv kept us biting our nails on the edge of the piste during his semi-final bout, once again against Ian Rugheimer winning with a double hit 15-14. Through to the final he quickly took a good lead and kept it, winning 15-9 to win Gold medal in his first competition. A fantastic result!

Well done to all who took part, and the way you fenced and supported each other. You made the coaches very proud!
