Men's Foil:

With Marc in semi-retirement (!) One Two Six was represented by Tom and George Hendrie. After a cautious start with three victories in the poule, George won his Last 64 fight, and then drew Joe Sale in the Last 32. Against the older, bigger opponent, he rushed a little at the start and fell behind. He regained his composure brilliantly to fight back, producing some lovely beat counter-attacks to draw ahead on several occasions. He was unlucky to lose in the end, but Jo and Marc were very impressed with his performance.

Tom conserved his energy (in true 'Bengry' style!) throughout the day, after a bout of illness during the week. He had little trouble through to the final where he saved his best for last. Facing the experienced Adam Wood in the final, Tom conceded the first two hits, but then took command and produced a fine display of varied moves including attacks, attacks on preparation, stop hits

and parry ripostes to take the next 10 hits in a row. Adam fought back and caught up a few hits, but Tom remained focused and in control to defend his Isle of Wight Open Championship. Well Done!

Women's Foil:

Amy Hyman and Leonora Mackinnon both fenced well in the first round, both winning all but one fight. Unfortunately they met in the last 8 and the club supporters were forced to sit on the metaphorical fence while the two friends vied for a place in the semi-final. Leonora eventually won through 15-13, but was very upset to have knocked her friend out of the competition. After regaining her composure she faced Nikki Barlow (16th in the U20 GB rankings) who had beaten her 5-1 in the first round, and with some well timed attacks and fast parry ripostes, won the fight to reach the final. For the Gold medal, Leonora faced Lucy Gibbs, a very experienced foilist. Lucy took an early lead in the first part of the fight, but Leonora regained her composure and fought back well. Lucy's early lead proved too much, however, and Leonora had to settle for the Silver Medal. An amazing result for Leonora, as she fences mainly Epee, and Foil is her second weapon. Well done!

Men's Epee:

An unfortunate lack of 'Puffins' meant that the only men's epeeist Jo had to run around watching was Lukas Kuhlmeier. He had a shaky start, losing his first fight because of failing weapons, but soon got back on track, winning with convincing scores like 5-1 and 5-0. With a high seed, he won through to the semi-final where he faced Dudley Tredger, a notoriously difficult opponent, with years of International experience under his belt. Lukas fenced well, but Dudley's unique style got the better of him in the end. Well done for achieving 3rd place and helping the One Two Six 'A' team win the team prize!

Women's Epee:

Jo Maynard, Ana O'Loughlin, Barbara Wanzenried and Leonora Mackinnon represented the club in the women's Epee event. In the first round Jo won all her fights and was seeded first. Ana exceeded all expectation in her very first competition and fenced very well to win two fights and a seeding of 27th. Barbara had a tough time winning only one fight, and Leonora struggled to find form after such a spectacular result in the foil the day before, also winning only one fight. Unfortunately Barbara and Leonora did not make the cut, but stayed to support their club-mates in the following rounds.

Ana faced the number 6 seed, Rachel Brookes and fenced amazingly well, taking instruction from Marc and Jo, and mixing her game, with some well timed stop-hits and counter-allacks to win 15-11. She then faced the eventual Silver Medallist Lindsay Bottoms, and again fenced brilliantly to score 11 hits. Well done to Ana for an amazing first competition, Marc and Jo hope that this will inspire her to double her efforts in training and compete again next season!

Jo progressed comfortably through to the semi-final where she met Chrissie Flounders (who she lost to at Birmingham in March). This time she resisted the temptation to change to a pistol grip and stuck with her pommel, and scored some good direct attacks to reach the final. The Gold Medal match was against Lindsay Bottoms, another pommeller, and so was destined to be a slow and cautious fight. Hits were traded until time ran out at 10-10. In the extra minute Jo was awarded priority and Lindsay was pressured to attack. Jo kept her distance and scored the winning hit with a stop-hit to arm, winning the title for the fourth time. Well done!
